

Community Trust Spetses Emergency Funding Application

Criteria for Emergency Funding

- The project must coincide with the values and goals of the CTS and must include one or more of its areas of interest.
- The project must have the local community as its focal point and to also promote the values of sustainable development.
- It is possible for two or more organisations to apply for emergency funding, in order to promote the networking and communication of local associations and organisations.
- The application must be filled in correctly and submitted at least one week before the event's or project's implementation.
- The funding is given once per project. The same organisation is permitted to apply anew for a future project.
- CTS will reply to the email address stated in the application with a positive or a negative answer regarding the funding.

6. Budget (detailed budgetary list, what will be covered by CTS's emergency funding? Materials, transportation, transport etc)
